Why 10 days? Ten is a number connected to divine order and also represents completeness, testing and divine authority. It is frequently associated with God's law and human responsibility.

Write 3 goals for your time of prayer and fasting:

Most of us are familiar with the 21-day Daniel Fast (Daniel 10: 1-3). Let's look at Daniel 10:12-17 12 "Please test your servants for ten days: Give us nothing but vegetables to eat and water to drink. 13 Then compare our appearance with that of the young men who eat the royal food, and treat your servants in accordance with what you see." 14 So he agreed to this and tested them for ten days. 15 At the end of the ten days they looked healthier and better nourished than any of the young men who ate the royal food. 16 So the guard took away their choice food and the wine they were to drink and gave them vegetables instead. 17 To these four young men God gave knowledge and understanding of all kinds of literature and learning. And Daniel could understand visions and dreams of all kinds.

YOU REACHED THE GOAL

The goal of Prayer & Fasting is to draw nearer to God. Biblical fasting always has to do with eliminating distractions for a spiritual purpose; it hits the reset button of our soul and renews us from the inside out. It also enables us to celebrate the goodness and mercy of God and prepares our hearts for the battles as well as all the good things God desires to bring into our lives.

Remember, your personal fast should present a level of challenge, but it is very important to know your body, your options and, most importantly, to seek God in prayer and follow the Holy Spirit's lead

FASTING DIRECTIVES:

DAY 1, JANUARY 22 – GOD OF ORDER

Scripture: I Corinthians 14:40

Theme: God is not the author of confusion

Prayer Focus: Invite God to expose disorder without shame

Declaration: “God, bring divine order to my thoughts, emotions, and decisions. Confusion is leaving my life. I walk in clarity.”

DAY 2, JANUARY 23 – HEAVENLY ORDER

Scripture: Psalm 103:20-21

Biblical Model: Angels obey instantly and in rank

Prayer Focus: Alignment of earth’s practice with Heaven’s protocols. Thy Kingdom come, thy will be done in earth AS IT

IS IN HEAVEN. “Vav” 2026/5786 (Hebrew Year) 6th letter meaning nail, hook symbolizing connection and securing).

Vav is the connecting word “AND.” Vav is the year God connects Heaven to earth. This earth to Heaven connection

is paramount because it will expose all things related to man (flesh), man made systems and structures that have exalted themselves above Him.

Even angels have specific assignments, not overlapping roles Hebrews 1:14. Angels are either sent, assigned or tasked. Confusion comes when people function outside their assignment.

Declaration: My life is aligned with Heaven’s commands.

I respond quickly to God and resist delay.

DAY 3, JANUARY 24 – CREATION ORDER

Scripture: Genesis 1:1-5

Biblical Model: God separated chaos and beauty was produced. God said and everything He saw was good.

Prayer Focus: Separation before multiplication

Declaration: “God is separating what doesn’t belong so what does can flourish. My life is being re-created in order.”

DAY 4: ORDER PRESERVES

Scripture: Genesis 6:14-22

Biblical Model: Noah followed God’s instructions exactly. Preserve means to keep or save from injury or destruction; to guard or defend from evil, harm, danger; to protect. (topical Bible)

Prayer Focus: Obedience even when it seems unnecessary.

Declaration: “My obedience is preserving my future. I will not deviate from God’s instructions.”

DAY 5: FINANCIAL ORDER

Scripture: Proverbs 3:9-10

Biblical Model: Joseph stored up before the famine.

Prayer Focus: Stewardship, budgeting, tithing, wise planning

Declaration: "My finances are coming into divine order. Waste is exposed, provision is protected, overflow is released."

DAY 6: FAMILY & GENERATIONAL ORDER

Scripture: Joshua 24:15

Biblical Model: God's covenant flows through households

Prayer Focus: Repairing family structure and roles.

Declaration: "My household is aligned with God's order. Generation confusion is broken. Peace rules my family."

DAY 7: SINGLE, MARRIED & COVENANT ORDER

SINGLE~

Scripture: I Peter 2:9; I Corinthians 7:1-17; Genesis 2:18-24

Biblical Model:

Prayer Focus: Ask God to order my desires, heal soul ties, remove counterfeit connections and prepare my heart for covenant (not just convenience)

Declaration: "I am submitted to God's covenant order. I will not settle for connection outside alignment. My heart, body and future are preserved for what God has ordained."

MARRIED~

Scripture: Ephesians 5:31-33

Biblical Model: Covenant requires protection and priority

Prayer Focus: Healing breaches, restoring intimacy and honor.

Declaration: "My marriage is realigned under God's covenant order. Outside interference is removed. Love and honor are restored."

DAY 8: VOCATION & CALLING ORDER

Scripture: Jeremiah 1:5

Biblical Model: God assigns before He sends.

Prayer Focus: Right timing, right assignments, right connections, mutually beneficial positions

Declaration: "My career and calling are ordered by God. I am not late, misplaced or overlooked.

DAY 9: CHURCH & KINGDOM ORDER

Scripture: Titus 1:5

Biblical Model: Leaders were instructed to set in order what was lacking.

Prayer Focus: Authority, unity, structure, succession

Declaration: "God is setting His house in order. My church walks in unity, wisdom and spiritual authority.

DAY 10: DIVINE RESET & SEALING

Scripture: Psalm 90:17

Biblical Model: Establish the work of our hands. Reset us for the current work and seal (secure, confirm and mark) us for the work ahead.

Prayer Focus: Seal everything God has reordered.

Declaration: "What God has reordered cannot be reversed. My life is established, stabilized and sealed in divine order."

PRAISE & PRAYER

Praise God you committed and followed through. We have reminded our flesh who is Lord over us. We left some things at the altar and will ease back into some of the other things we may have been involved in prior to our time of consecration. Let the words of my mouth and the meditation my heart be acceptable in thy sight Oh Lord my strength and my redeemer.

Our spiritual instructions for January is "Order in the Court!" This is not merely getting our affairs in order under a divine judgment. This mandate is to order (align, sort, edit, renew, clarify) every area of our lives ("the court"). The "court" is Heaven's perspective of every place you have authority, connection, rights; that which has been placed in your hands and your spheres of influence. Our praying, fasting, reading, and

fellowshipping will aide in bringing order to our lives as well as do the work God has called us to do. This is personal yet we will witness corporate benefits. The Lord is requiring significant sacrifices this year.

It is our prayer that you sense the urgency of obedience and choose this moment of sacrifice for the greater good.

Our declaration for the year:

This year, my life will be aligned.

My worship will be exclusive.

My house will be ordered.

My covenant will be honored.

I choose alignment over comfort,
obedience over emotion, and order!

“We will worship God.
